



ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES FOR SYDNEY CHRISTADELPHIAN JUNIOR CYC

JCYC will continue to be live-streamed via Zoom and YouTube.

JCYC attendees: 45 maximum (excluding event organisers)

Event Organisers: JCYC Committee Members and presenters

Role of Event Organiser:

- Overall supervision of the activity.
- Organise attendance roll via invitation and RSVP
- Ensure attendance does not exceed current restrictions of 45 people.
- Ensure Riverwood Christadelphian Covid-19 Safety Plan is adhered to and that all attendees are aware of the JCYC conditions of entry.
- Ensure students are ticked off the attendance roll and checked into the NSW Govt QR Code.
- Ensure adults in attendance (eg presenters, event organiser) have registered via QR scan or attendance roll
- Co-ordinate hall set up and cleaning.
- Ensure good social distancing and hand hygiene occurs and that masks are being worn for anyone over 13 years of age.

GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN

- ✓ Masks required indoors for anyone 13 years and over.
- ✓ No singing hymns/songs
- ✓ Do not hug or kiss – be mindful of safe distance
- ✓ Sanitise hands on the way into the hall and on the way out
- ✓ Wash hands after going to the bathroom
- ✓ Students to bring their own water bottle
- ✓ The kitchen is out of bounds
- ✓ Students need to bring their own equipment like pens, highlighters and pencils

GUIDELINES FOR SPEAKERS / YOUTH LEADERS

- ✓ Masks required indoors for anyone 13 years and over.
- ✓ Teachers must sit 1.5 m away from students e.g. across a table
- ✓ Do not share pens, paper, bible marking pens, highlighters etc or devices or anything else between students – students must have their own equipment
- ✓ Do not cause congestion at the entrance to the hall
- ✓ Bring your own water bottle

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- ✓ Do NOT send any of your family members if they do not meet the Conditions of Entry
- ✓ Definitely do NOT send any members of your family if they are sick
- ✓ Check your child/ren in using the NSW Govt QR Code at the front gate or front door.
- ✓ Collect your children at the front gate
- ✓ Do not come into the hall unless you have checked on density levels and are wearing a mask.
- ✓ Do not cause congestion at the entrance to the hall.
- ✓ Children must be picked up by 9.30PM at the latest
